1 **Magnolia Historic Preservation District**

Area generally bounded by Harding Way, California Street, Flora Street and El Dorado Street.  
Designated by Stockton City Council – 7/30/84

2 **Doctors' Row Historic Preservation District**

Area generally bounded by California Street, Acacia Street, Poplar Street and American Street on the former Stockton Development Center grounds, now CSU Stockton site. (Affected properties include 504, 520, 521, 560 and 604 East Acacia Street).  
Designated by Stockton City Council – 5/13/85
