

# Stockton Area Water Suppliers' Water Conservation Education

The Stockton Area Water Suppliers (California Water Service Company, City of Stockton, Stockton East Water District, and San Joaquin County) believe that the best way to encourage the wise use of our water resources is through education.



All Stockton metropolitan area schools are invited to participate in our stimulating, age appropriate and fun-filled water education programs, which are designed to support teachers' lesson plans and align with the current California Content Standards.



These programs are free of charge for public and private schools within the Stockton Area Water Suppliers' service area, and are currently available for Kindergarten through Grade 3.

**Kindergarten & 1st Grade Program**  
48 minutes

A flannel board story presentation helps students gain an understanding of the connection between water forms, temperature and weather. After a brief introduction to the water cycle, a fun video encourages children to use water wisely.

**2nd & 3rd Grade Program**  
50 minutes

An in-depth look at the hydrologic cycle and the Earth's limited water supply helps students understand the scientific and practical concepts behind our ever growing need for conservation. After tracing water's journey from source to tap, students see a water filtering demonstration and view an entertaining video from the California Department of Water Resources about the water cycle.

*Participating teachers are provided with a printable water conservation activity booklet on CD. Each child receives educational activity material.*
