STOCKTON POLICE RESERVE OFFICER APPLICANT QUESTIONNAIRE

This is not a test, but a questionnaire covering the requirements and qualifications necessary to appoint a Reserve Police Officer with the City of Stockton. This is a volunteer position with the City of Stockton.

Read each question carefully. These questions will be asked again during the detailed interview at the Stockton Police Department and verified by a polygraph examination. Any false answers knowingly given are just cause for denying or terminating your application.

After completing the questionnaire, you should be able to determine if you meet the qualifying requirements. RESERVE POLICE OFFICER

Applications are now being accepted for the position of Entry Level Reserve Police Officer (Level 1, 2 or 3) and Lateral Reserve Police Officer (Level 1, 2, or 3).

REQUIREMENTS

Must be 21 years of age on or before appointment date.

Must be a U.S. citizen or permanent resident alien who is eligible for and has applied for citizenship.

Must possess a high school diploma or GED equivalent.

Must possess a valid California drivers license and have automobile insurance coverage.

Must reside within 45 minutes of the Stockton Police Department.

Must pass a psychological evaluation, a polygraph examination, background investigation and a medical examination.

All applicants for Entry Level 1 must have completed the P.O.S.T. Basic Law Enforcement Academy. Entry Level 2 applicants must have completed the P.O.S.T. Module II and P.O.S.T. Module III.

Lateral Reserve Police Officer Level 1 or 2 cannot have any break in service, which means during the transfer, the reserve officer must remain appointed at his or her current agency until after he/she is sworn in as a Stockton Reserve Police Officer.

All Applicants must successfully complete a P.O.S.T. Field Training Officer Program. Failure to complete training will automatically disqualify the officer.

The Stockton Police Department will supply all uniforms and equipment.

DUTIES

Upon completion of the FTO training, Level 1 Reserve Police Officers will perform the same duties as the regular police officers throughout the department and shall have full Peace Officer Status while on duty.

Upon completion of the FTO training, Level 2 Reserve Police Officer duties will be limited to patrol, under the direct supervision of a regular officer and/or specific events as directed by the Reserve Program Manager.
