

**CITY OF STOCKTON
REQUEST FOR SEALED BID
FOR THE PURCHASE OF HOT MIX ASPHALT
(PUR 06-054)**

The City of Stockton has made the following modifications to the project:

Bid opening date has been changed to June 29, 2006.

Delete all references to Project A and Project B.

Delete Section 2.11 (Alternate A, Applies) and insert Section 2.10.1 as follows:

2.10.1 The City of Stockton hereby invites quotations for furnishing their requirements of Hot Mix Asphalt as needed for the period of July 1, 2006 through June 30, 2007.

See the following bidding schedule.

The quotations are to be for material at bidder's Hot Mix Asphalt plant with pickup to be made by the City on an "as-needed" basis.

Bids are required for the entire work. The amount-of-the bid for comparison purposes will be the total of all items. The total of unit basis items will be determined by extension of the item price bid on the basis of the estimated quantity set forth for the item. The bidder shall set forth for each item of work, in clearly, legible figures, an item price and a total for the item in the respective spaces provided for this purpose. In the case of unit basis items, the amount set forth under the "Total" column shall be the extension of the item price bid on the basis of the estimated quantity for the item.

In case of discrepancy between the item price and the total set forth for the item, the item price shall prevail, provided, however, if the amount set forth as an item price is ambiguous, unintelligible or uncertain for any cause, or is omitted, or in case of unit basis items, is the same amount as the entry in the "Total" column, then the amount set forth in the "Total" column for the item shall prevail in accordance with the following:

- (1) As to lump sum items, the amount set forth in the "Total" column shall be the item price.
- (2) As to unit basis items, the amount set forth in the "Total" column shall be divided by the estimated quantity for the item and the price thus obtained shall be the item price.

Delete Section 2.12 (Alternate B, Applies) and insert the Section 2.10.2 as follows:

2.10.2 COMPENSATION ADJUSTMENTS FOR PRICE FLUCTUATIONS

The provisions of this section shall apply only to the following contract items:

Item Number	Item
1	¾" Type "A" Hot Mix Asphalt
2	½" Type "B" Hot Mix Asphalt
3	3/8" Type "B" Hot Mix Asphalt
4	¼" Type "B" Hot Mix Asphalt

The compensation payable for asphalt concrete will be increased or decreased in conformance with the provisions of this section for paving asphalt price fluctuations exceeding 10 percent (lu/lb is greater than 1.10 or less than 0.90) which occur during performance of the work.

The adjustment in compensation will be determined in conformance with the following formulate when the item of asphalt concrete is included in a monthly estimate:

- A. Total monthly adjustment = AQ
- B. For an increase in paving asphalt price index exceeding 10 percent:

$$A. = 0.90 (lu/lb - 1.10) lb$$

- C. For a decrease in paving asphalt price index exceeding 10 percent:

$$A = 0.90 (lu/lb - 0.90) lb$$

- D. Where:

- A = Adjustment in dollars per ton of paving asphalt used to produce asphalt concrete, rounded to the nearest \$0.01.
- lu = The California Statewide Paving Asphalt Price Index which is in effect on the first business day of the month in which the quantity subject to adjustment was supplied.
- lb = The California Statewide Paving Asphalt Price Index for the month in which the bid opening for the project occurred.
- Q = Quantity in tons of paving asphalt that was used in producing the quantity of asphalt concrete supplied for the month.

The adjustment in compensation will also be subject to the following:

The compensation adjustments provided herein will be shown separately on payment estimates. The Contractor shall be liable to the City for decreased compensation adjustments and the City may deduct the amount thereof from any moneys due or that may become due the Contractor.

The California Statewide Paving Asphalt Price Index is determined each month on the first business day of the month by the California Department of Transportation (DOT) using the median of posted prices in effect as posted by Chevron, Mobil, and Unocal for the Buena Vista, Huntington Beach, Kern river, Long Beach, Midway Sunset and Wilmington fields.

In the event that the companies discontinue posting their prices for a field, the California DOT will determine an index from the remaining posted prices. The California DOT reserves the right to include in the index determination the posted prices of additional fields.
