

NOTICE INVITING PROPOSALS

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Request for Proposals (RFP) are invited by the City of Stockton, California for specifications for **WATERFRONT CONNECTIONS PLAN (PUR 09-053)** in strict accordance with the specifications.

The City of Stockton is seeking proposals from consulting firms to evaluate, rank, locate, and conceptually design an alternative transportation network that will enhance and improve access into the downtown area using Stockton's historic waterfront amenities as the focal point, as a portion of the Waterfront Connections Plan. More specifically, the City is interested in soliciting bids from (A) a Planning and Design firm for a "Master Plan", and (B) an Engineering Firm for property investigation. It is the preference of the City that a "team" providing expertise in both areas (planning and engineering) be developed and submitted as one response; however responses will be accepted as a partial project provider, and will be considered if sufficient singular responses are received.
