  - RTD Complaint Process
    - 72 hours to contact person who made the complaint.
    - Five days to investigate, document and resolve.
  - The committee would like to have a quarterly meeting with each City department.
  - Gordon MacKay, Deputy Director of Public Works, was available for issues related to the department.
    - Mr. MacKay explained that a major capital project has a design team which includes someone from transit, the County, the State, etc. There would also be a "Public Notification Person" assigned to the team.
    - Mr. MacKay also explained that many times when sidewalks are being ripped up it is by PG&E, the phone company, etc. They must notify one week before demolition starts.
