**FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS (FAQ)**

How are the lunches purchased?	Checks payable to "City of Stockton" 2 tickets (per agency) will be provided to participants Tickets can be purchased at the event
What does the lunch include?	Hamburger/Hot Dog, Chips, Drink, Cookie for \$5
Is there a form to fill out for lunch tickets?	Send your check payable to "City of Stockton" with the registration form
Can an agency request a specific spot for their booth?	Yes, a layout of the grounds can be provided.
What time can set up begin?	7:00 a.m.
Will the lunch tickets be mailed?	No, they will be held under your agency name at the fair registration table.
What is the cost of the space/booth?	\$25
Are tables and chairs provided?	Yes, one 6' table and two chairs per agency
Will table covers be provided?	White plastic table covers will be available.
Will shade/canopy be provided?	No, you must provide your own.
Can vendors and agencies attend for a limited time?	We strongly recommend that you stay for the whole event to get the best possible exposure of your services to the public.
What sort of prizes are you looking for the raffle?	Any donation is appreciated. We will be giving out small items for game participation and larger items for raffles. A typical gift for the raffle would be a gift card to a local store.
What is the expected attendance	500-600
What is the physical address for Weber Point Event Center?	221 N. Center Street
Where do participants park & off load during the event?	The Weber Point Event Center Lot is reserved for the Vendors and Entertainers. A parking pass will be required.
Where do attendees park?	There will be parking around the vicinity of Weber Point at meters and on the streets. Most meters are one hour, some two, and up to 10 hours. The meters only take quarters.
