	2.	I was born on June 8, 1949, and am 63 years old. I live at 922 Castle Oaks
Drive, Stockton, California.		on, California.
	3.	I was hired by the City of Stockton in April of 1978 and retired in November of
2003 as a Police Officer.		ce Officer.
	4.	My spouse is my dependent on the City's Health Plan. We both have enough
quarters to qualify for Medicare.		alify for Medicare.
	5.	My PERS retirement check is \$5836.07. My household annual income is
\$63,442.00.		
	6.	I am informed and believe that the City has adopted a monthly premium for
retiree health benefits. If required to pay this premium to receive City Health Plan benefits, e		
	with a \$300 subsidy that has been offered by the City for one year, my premium would be	
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\$1276.66 monthly or \$15,319.92 annually. This would represent approximately 24% of my income. Paying this premium indicates that I will be paying more for insurance than I do for a house payment.
