2 1. I have personal knowledge of the facts set forth in this declaration and, if called as

6 3. I was hired by the City of Stockton in April of 1978 and retired in November of

9 quarters to qualify for Medicare.


10 5. My PERS retirement check is \$5836.07. My household annual income is

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1 \$1276.66 monthly or \$15,319.92 annually. This would represent approximately 24% of my
