HOT Team (Homeless Outreach Team)

- June 24, 2021 55 unsheltered individuals contacted
- Hazelton Ave. between California St. & Stanislaus St.; Beneath Hwy 4 @ Stanislaus St.
- Stockton Fire, Stockton PD, SJC Behavioral Health, Community Medical Center, St. Mary's Dining, Salvation Army & Stockton Family Shelter
- Provided food, water, and hygiene kits; fire prevention education, including use of extension cords; Community Medical assessed and referred individuals for follow-up appointments.

Homeless Encampment Clean-ups

- June 26, 2021 Public Works & Police Department Mormon Slough between Aurora St. & California St.
 - 58 truck loads were removed, totaling 81 tons
 - YTD: 652 truck loads removed, totaling 1,049 tons

- Opened to applications March 15 (noon); application deadline extended until all funds are used:

- 2,866 applications completed & submitted; 1,654 approved.
- \$7,182,906 obligated to date.
- Assistance for low-income households, rent and utilities.
