- March 20, 2021 - Mormon Slough: Wilson Wy to Airport Wy
- 30 truckloads, resulting in 68 tons of debris removed

City of Stockton Emergency Rental Assistance Program (ERAP)

- Opened to applications March 15 (noon); application deadline April 30 (5 p.m.)
- 155 applications completed & submitted
- 863 applications under development
