HOUSING & HOMELESSNESS

HOT Team (Homeless Outreach Team)

- **May 6, 2021** - 17 unsheltered individuals contacted
- 4900 block of US-99 Frontage Road near Stockton Verde Mobile Home Park; East Hammer Lane near railroad overpass at Lorraine Avenue
- Stockton Fire, Stockton PD, SJC Behavioral Health, SJC Sheriff Department, Saint Mary's Dining Hall, Community Medical Center
- Ensuring unsheltered persons had the necessary identification to be eligible for state programs, food, water and service brochures provided, firefighters focused on fire safety and separation distances from cooking and sleeping areas.
- COVID-19 screening - no COVID-19 signs or symptoms.

Homeless Encampment Clean-ups

- **May 7, 2021** - Public Works & Police Department - Mormon Slough: Aurora St. to San Joaquin St.
 - 26 truck loads were removed, totaling 44 tons
 - YTD: 520 truck loads have been removed, totaling 852 tons

City of Stockton Emergency Rental Assistance Program (ERAP)

- Opened to applications March 15 (noon); application deadline extended until all funds are used: www.stocktonca.gov/renthelp
- **1,880** applications completed & submitted; **670** approved.
- **\$1,354,743** obligated to date.
- Assistance for low-income households, rent and utilities.
