

COVID-19 WEEKLY UPDATE MAY 24, 2021

STATE OF CALIFORNIA

- Statewide COVID-19 updated May 24, 2021 (data from May 23, 2021):
 - 3,674,044 cases to-date; 1,081 cases today
 - 61,762 deaths to-date; 7 deaths today
 - Tests 64,576,707 to-date: 179,934 today
 - Vaccines administered: 36,364,200
- State COVID-19 Rates updated May 18, 2021
 - Daily new cases (per 100K) 3.2
 - Positivity rate 1.1%
 - ICU statewide availability 32.8%

- Positivity rate 2.5%
- Health Equity Quartile Positivity Rate 2.8%
- Totals to-date (May 24, 2021 1:16 p.m.)
- Cases 73,617
- Recovered 71.287
- Active Cases 927
- **Deaths** 1,403
- Rates per 10K in population:
 - 1 Escalon (992.24); 2 Stockton (981.56);
 - 3 Lodi (907.85); 4 Lathrop (894.05);
 - 5 Ripon (883.87); 6 Manteca (837.97);
 - 7 Tracy (777.331); 8 Unincorporated (755.23)
- Hospitalizations (May 21, 2021):
 - 30 patients with COVID admitted for care; ICUs at 89% capacity
 - San Joaquin County hospitals reported 0 patient death in the prior 24 hours.
 - COVID-related hospitalizations have decreased by 16.7% over the past week.

HOUSING & HOMELESSNESS

HOT Team (Homeless Outreach Team)

- May 20, 2021 50 unsheltered individuals contacted.
- Highway 99: Waterloo, Cherokee and Arch/Airport; I-5 and Trinity Parkway; I-5 and Country Club Blvd.; I-5 and Monte Diablo Ave.
- Stockton Fire, Stockton PD, SJC Behavioral Health, St. Mary's Homeless Shelter, Community Medical Center, Salvation Army, SJC Probation, Women's Center, Veteran Housing
- Educated residents on protecting their camps and belongings from fires, having cooking fires in approved containers and fire prevention safety; notified residents of available resources; provided sandwiches and hygiene kits;

City of Stockton Emergency Rental Assistance Program (ERAP)

- Opened to applications March 15 (noon); application deadline extended until all funds are used: www.stocktonca.gov/renthelp
- 2,120 applications completed & submitted; 916 approved.
- \$2,911,927 obligated to date.
- Assistance for low-income households, rent and utilities.
