CITY OF STOCKTON ACCEPTING APPLICATIONS ***Stockton Building and Housing Board of Appeals***

(Stockton, CA) - The City of Stockton is currently accepting applications for seven (7) vacancies on the Stockton Building and Housing Board of Appeals. The vacancies are due to the expired terms of all members. The term of office is four (4) years. The deadline for applications is Wednesday, November 30, 2011 at 5:30 p.m.

To qualify, applicants must be residents of the City of Stockton and not hold any public office or position of employment with the City of Stockton. The Board consists of two (2) members from the Construction field, such as General Building Contractor, Plumbing Contractor, Electrical Contractor, Mechanical Contractor, Engineer or Architect, who will also serve on the Handicapped Access Board of Appeals; two (2) disabled persons and one (1) member from the lay-community.

The purpose of this Board is to hear appeals of administrative decision from aggrieved parties, relative to the application of the general building, zoning, and related

regulations of the City of Stockton, including the Mechanical Code, Plumbing Code, Electrical Code, Housing Code, or related sections of the Stockton Municipal Code. This Board also grants variances in appropriate cases from administrative applications of the regulations where the public welfare will not be compromised.

The Building and Housing Board of Appeals meets as-needed on the third Wednesday of the month at 5:45 p.m. at the Community Development Department Permit Center, 345 N. El Dorado Street. Remuneration is \$20 per meeting, not to exceed \$120 per month.
