### **Stockton Accepting Applications for Cultural Heritage Board Vacancy**

(Stockton, CA) - The City of Stockton is currently accepting applications for one vacancy on the nine-member (9) Cultural Heritage Board, due to the resignation of one of its members. Full terms are for four (4) years. The person appointed will serve the remainder of the term held by the resigning member. The term will commence upon appointment and end October 31, 2011. The deadline for applications is Wednesday, April 27, 2011, at 6:00 p.m.

Appointments are made by the Planning Commission and ratified by the City Council. Applicants must reside in the city of Stockton and not hold any public office or position of employment with the City of Stockton.

The Cultural Heritage Board was formed to preserve and promote the City's historical, cultural and architectural resources and to advise City officials in these matters. Responsibilities include the evaluation of historically and architecturally significant buildings and sites, the nomination of landmarks and historic districts, the sponsorship of the Award of
