Championship Flight

- ♦ **Men** - Low gross winner designated "Stockton City Champion."
- ♦ **Women** - Low gross winner designated "Stockton City Champion."
- ♦ **Handicap Flight:** Entrants will be divided into flights based upon handicaps. The grouping will depend upon the handicap distribution among the entrants.
- ♦ **Senior Flight:** Players 55 and over may choose this flight. One prize each awarded for low gross and low net.

Award of Prizes

Tied Scores

Championship flight ties will be decided by sudden death playoff. Handicap flight ties will be decided by card match.

Rules

- ♦ When starting times are assigned, the schedule must be followed.
- ♦ Contestants must check in with starter for tee assignment at least half an hour prior to starting time.
- ♦ No extra hole play will be permitted. The penalty is disqualification.
- ♦ Time schedules will be posted in the Van Buskirk and Swenson Pro Shops.
- ♦ USGA rules will apply except as modified by local rules and rules committee.
- ♦ All putts must be holed out or disqualification will be automatic.

Playing Conditions For Tournament

♦ **Eligibility**
Any amateur golfer who reached his/her 15th birthday by Saturday, August 1, 2008.

♦ **How To Enter**

♦ **Entry Deadline**
ALL entries must be received by **Stockton Parks and Recreation** (in person or mail) by **Friday, July 24, at 5 p.m.**

No late entries accepted. Entries received without the entry fee will not be accepted. Entries are limited to the first 288 paid entrants.

♦ **Entry Fee**
\$100 includes two rounds of golf, trophies and prizes. Fee (payable to the **City of Stockton**) must accompany entry form. Cart fees extra.

Monthly tickets are not recognized for this event. No refunds.

♦ **Type of Play**
All entrants will be divided into two groups: official handicap (men and women), and the championship group. Each group will engage in medal play

and play 36 holes. (See note under Schedule of Play).

♦ **Handicaps**
Entrants competing on the basis of established handicaps will use recognized handicaps from clubs affiliated with the Northern/Southern California Golf Associations. The Handicap Chairperson or Golf Professional of the player's club shall certify handicaps. Entrants must have an established NCGA/SCGA number and index.



Each handicap competitor shall be placed in flights based upon their handicap at the time the application is submitted.

However, July handicap shall be the official handicap for the tournament. For handicaps that change up or down, no adjustments will be made.

Schedule of Play

♦ **Championship Group**
All amateur entries will be accepted regardless of handicap. Those with handicaps 5 and under will automatically be placed in this flight.

♦ **Handicap Group/Eligibility - Men** - Established handicaps of 6 or more. One round will be played at Swenson and one round will be played at Van Buskirk.

Women - Established handicaps. One round will be played at Swenson and
