Are You Better on the Driving Range than the Golf Course?

As a PGA Professional for over twenty years, students often come to me with the statement, "I practice and do well on the driving range, and then the result is different on the golf course." It's amazing to me that people go from a relatively decent swing on the driving range and then head to the first tee and, to quote some of the golfers, "fall apart." The reality of the situation is that as soon as a golfer has the added pressure of playing with peers, the hit impulse, and intended targets, the surroundings have changed and their practice swing (mechanics) and their driving range swing may disappear. Only to find out there is a third swing in their muscle memory, the golf course swing.

I have always felt as an instructor, and a golfer myself, that people have three swings in their muscle memory. 1) Practice Swing, 2) Driving Range Swing, and 3) the Golf Course Swing (some golfers even have an additional Tournament Swing). The key to being an accomplished player is to have these swings come together, to merge the muscle memory.

Many golfers spend hours on the driving range believing that's what will improve their score. However, the opportunity lies in consulting a PGA Professional who is trained on the correct mechanics of the golf swing and can take you on the golf course for a playing lesson - perhaps your issue isn't in the overall swing, it's the short game. Therefore, the City of Stockton is providing the community an opportunity to sign up for individual or group lessons by a PGA Professional. Focus your time and effort where it counts, you can coordinate your skills to ensure the three swings become one on the golf course.
